limited time;" to ascertain and fix a true and  
just Composition for all Tithes, arising, growing,  
yielding, or payable, within the Parish of  
Castlerahan, in the County of Cavan, do hereby  
Certify, that the true and just amount of Composition  
for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish,  
is Three Hundred and Four Pounds One Shilling  
and Ten Pence Halfpenny, British, by the year,  
which Sum is due and payable to the Very Rev<sup>d</sup>  
Henry Vesey Fitz Gerald, Dean of Kilmore, as a  
Composition for the Tithes claimable by him, as  
Rector of the said Parish -

And we do further Certify, that the  
Average Price of Oats, being the Corn principally  
grown in said County, for the period of Seven years  
ending on the first day of November, 1821, is Fifteen  
Shillings and Two Pence farthing, per barrel
