

We, the undersigned occupiers of Land, in the Parish
of Castlebar, duly qualified by payment of Rates
to vote in Special Vestry under the Tithe Composition
Act, together with the Rector and Church Wardens of S.^d
Parish have the Honor of Stating to the Chief Secretary for
the Information of his Excellency the Lord Lieutenant that
we assembled in the Church of S.^d Parish at one o'clock
post Meridian on Thursday the 3^d of February 1825, viz,
after due Consideration we determined it was not Expedient
to carry S.^d Act into Operation at present in this Parish,

And Therefore have adjourned, sine die -
We beg leave further to state that it is very uncertain,
Whether some of those who applied for a Special Vestry
were strictly qualified by law to do so, having alienated
a portion of their vicarual Holdings, and it is supposed
do not Individually pay an Annual Rent, sufficient
to Entitle them to memorial.
