varied and increased or diminished and amended
accordingly And whereas said Sir John Wrixon
Becher William Wrixon Becher William Rogers
Johnson. Bryan Augustine W. Swiney and
Thomas Boyce pursuant to said Notice lodged
their petition in writing dated the 11th day of
June 1896 setting forth the premises to the
Clerk of the Crown and Peace for both Counties East
Riding and duly made application in writing
for the purposes aforesaid to the Justices of the
Peace for the County of both assembled at the
said General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held
at Kaintock in and for said County of both and
in and for both County East Riding and Division
of Mallow (being the County in which said parish
of Hastenwagner is situate) on the 26th day of
June 1896 And whereas said application
duly came on for hearing before the Justices
assembled at the said General Quarter Sessions of
the Peace held at Kaintock in and for said
County Riding and Division the 26th day of
June 1896 and was duly heard and considered
by said Justices in presence of the said applicants
and their Counsel and of Richard Edmund
Longfield claiming to be entitled to the proportion of

said Composition and Rent charge payable to the
Lay Impropriator and his Counsel and was by
order of said Justices adjourned to the then
ensuing General Quarter Sessions of the Peace
in and for said County Riding and Division
that is to say the General Quarter Sessions of the
Peace at Mallow in and for said County the
16th day of November 1896 for further Consideration
And whereas said application duly came
on for hearing at said last mentioned General
Quarter Sessions of the Peace before the Justices
there assembled the said 16th day of November
1896 in presence of said parties and their Counsel
and after further debate was by order of said
Justices further adjourned to their next ensuing
General Quarter Sessions of the Peace in and for said
County Riding and Division that is to say to these
present General Quarter Sessions of the Peace for
further consideration And whereas the said
General Quarter Sessions of the Peace to which said
application was first made as aforesaid was duly
continued for the purposes of said application
thence thenceforward And the said application having
come on for hearing before us the Justices assembled
at these present General Quarter Sessions of the Peace
pursuant to said orders of adjournment Now
we the said Justices having duly considered said
