set forth in the original Certificate of said John Lynch and accordingly we do adjudge and order that the Composition for all Tithes and the Rent charge in lieu thereof now payable in said parish of Castlemaquoid to Richard Edmund Longfield Esquire as Lay Impropriator of said parish be varied and diminished for the seven years ensuing the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1896 in such manner and to such extent that the amount of such Composition and Rent charge for and during the said 7 years ensuing said 1<sup>st</sup> day of November 1896 shall bear the like proportion to the amount of the Composition set forth in said original Certificate of said John Lynch as payable to said Richard Edmund Longfield as said Lay Impropriator and to the Rent charge heretofore payable in lieu thereof as the average price of wheat for the 7 years preceding herunto that is to say seventeen shillings and five pence three farthings bears to the average price thereof set forth in said original Certificate that is to say one pence twelve shillings and ten pence per barrel and accordingly that the amount of the said Composition payable to said Richard Edmund Longfield as Lay Impropriator be varied and diminished from the sum of £404. 12. 6<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> to the sum of £215. 8. 1<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> by the year and that the amount of the Rent charge now payable to said Richard Edmund Longfield as Lay Impropriator in
