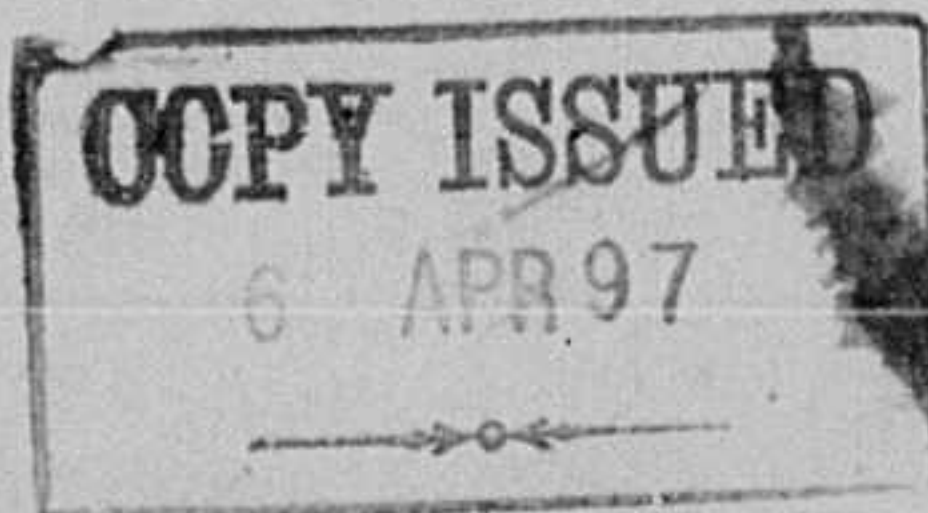


J. L. Lynch, Commissioner, duly appointed and sworn under and by
virtue of an Act passed in the second and third years of the Reign of
King William the fourth entitled an Act to amend three Acts passed
respectively in the fourth, fifth, seventh and eighth years of the reign of
His late Majesty King George the fourth, providing for the establishing
of Composition for tithes in Ireland, and to make such Compositions
permanent to ascertain and fix the true and just amount of Composition
for all tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable in the Parish of
Castlemagner in the Diocese of Cloyne and County of Cork do hereby
Certify that the true and just amount of Composition for all tithes
whatever in said Parish is eight Hundred and nine pounds five
Shillings and one penny Strg. by the year, of which sum of eight Hun-
-dred and nine pounds five Shillings and one penny four Hundred
and four pounds twelve Shillings and six pence halfpenny are due
and payable to the Rev. Joseph R. Cotton as a Composition for the
Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish, and the sum of
four Hundred and four pounds twelve Shillings & six pence halfpenny
are due and payable to Jeremiah Callaghan Esq. lay Impropriator
of said Parish, and I do further Certify that the average price of Wheat
being the Corn principally grown in said County for the period of
seven years ending on the 1st day of November 1830, is one pound
twelve Shillings & ten pence per Barrel,
Dated this 15th day of Oct. 1833.
