Dublin Castle, 21st Oct
1823

Gentlemen,

Whereas by an Act passed in
the 4th Year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled
"An Act to provide for the establishing of Com-
positions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited
time," It is enacted - That at any time after the
passing of the said Act it shall be lawful for the
Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor or
Governors of Ireland, upon the Application
of the Rector, Vicar, or other Ecclesiastical
Incumbent, or of any ImproPRIATOR, or other
Person or Persons entitled to any Tithes or portion
of Tithes, or of any Five or more of the Owners or
occupiers of Land, each holding or possessing
Lands of the Yearly Value (if owners) or at the
Yearly Rent (if occupiers) of not less than
£20 in any Parish in Ireland to give orders
and directions, from time to time, when and as
such Lord Lieutenant or other Chief Governor
