I Charles Nash Commissioner duly appointed and sworn
under and by virtue of an act made in the second and
third year of the reign of His Majesty King George the fourth Intituled an act
to amend three acts passed respectively in the fourth fifth
and in the seventh and eighth years of the reign of his
Late Majesty King George the fourth Providing for the
Establishing of compensation for Tithes in Ireland &c. make
such compensation permanent To ascertain and fix
a true and just compensation for all Tithes whatever arising
growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Carton
in the County of Dunelm I do hereby certify that the true and
just amount of compensation for all Tithes whatever within
the said Parish is two hundred Pounds six Shillings and
five Pence yearly by the year which said sum of
£200. 6. 5 1/2 by the year is due and payable to the Revd
Elias Thackeray as a compensation for the Tithes claimable
by him as Rector of said Parish

And I do further certify that the average Price of wheat
(being the corn principally grown in such County) from
first day of Nov 1823 and End of the first day of Nov
1830 as extracted from Dublin Gazette is
