within the Parish of Castletown in the County of South  
Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of  
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish  
is two hundred Pounds six Shillings and five Pence per Annum  
by the year which said sum of £200 n 6 s 5/4 by the year is due  
& payable to the Rev. Elias Thackeray as a composition for the  
Tithe claimable by him as rector of the said Parish  
And I do further certify that the average Price of Wheat  
(being the corn principally grown in such County) from the  
first day of Nov. 1823 and ending the first day of Nov.  
1830 as extracted from Dublin Gazette is
