

To ALL whom these Presents shall come, I *the Rev^d George Cusford D.D.* Incumbent of the Parish of *Cloubony* in the County of Longford send Greeting, WHEREAS, *George Beatty Moore* in the County of *Longford Clerk* - has truly served me with a Notice in Writing, in the Words and Figures following,

SIR,—You are hereby required to take Notice, that in pursuance of an Act passed in the second and third year of his present Majesty, entitled, an Act to amend three Acts passed respectively in the fourth, fifth, and in the seventh and eighth years of the Reign of his late Majesty, King George the Fourth, providing for establishing of COMPOSITION of TITHES in Ireland; and to make such Compositions permanent, I *George Beatty Moore* of *Bawnmore* in the County of *Longford Clerk* being *seized in Leasehold Interest* of All That and Those,

The lands of Malinaserau, situated on the road from Granard to St. Johnstown, bounded on the North, by the Glebe land of Cloubony and Kellys farm in another division of said Townland, on the South, by another portion of the Glebe land, on the East, by the townland of Cloubin, and on the West, by Part's division of Malinaserau. Also a small farm adjoining the village of St. Johnstown let to Henry Reynolds, & known by the name of The High Park, situated on the road leading from St. Johnstown to Granard and nearly surrounded by the Townland called Schooland, all being situate in the Parish of *Cloubony* Barony of *Granard* and County of *Longford* or otherwise entitled, according to the Provisions of said Act, to agree for and undertake the Payment of the Composition for Tithes lawfully payable for and in respect of such Lands, do hereby signify to you my desire to agree for and undertake the Payment of such Composition as aforesaid, for and in respect of the said Lands, and I hereby require you to grant me a Certificate in Writing, conformable to the Provisions of said Act, declaring me entitled to the benefit of this Notice, and to perform the other matters on your part required by the said Act to be done.

Now I, the said *George Cusford* Rector and Incumbent of the said Parish of *Cloubony* do by this Certificate, under my hand and seal, acknowledge the receipt of said Notice, and do certify and declare, that the said *George Beatty Moore* is entitled to the benefit of such Notice, pursuant to the Provisions of the said Act, so far as relates to the several Lands and Premises in said Notice mentioned, and charged with the Composition for Tithes for said Parish, and which Lands are more particularly set forth in the Map hereunto annexed.
