within the Parish of Clonohad - in the Diocese of Derry
and County of Donegal -

Do hereby certify that the true and just
amount of Compositions for all Tithes whatsoever within the
said Parish is Five hundred and fifty five Pounds British,
by the year, to continue invariable for twenty one years from
the first day of November next. The Glebe of said Parish
to be Tithable according to an agreement made between the
Rev^d Richard Hammetton Rector of said Parish, and a special
Oathy held in the Church of said Parish, on the 12th day of June
One thousand eight hundred and twenty seven, and which
sum is due and payable to the Rev^d Richard Hammetton
Rector of the above mentioned Parish -
