Commissioners duly appointed and Sworn under, and by  
Virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign  
of King George the Fourth, intituled "An Act for establish-  
ing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited  
time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition  
for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within  
the Parish of Cloncha in the Diocese of Derry and County  
of Donegal.

Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount of  
Composition for all Tithes whatever within the said  
Parish is Five Hundred and Fifty five Pounds British  
by the Year to continue invariable for Twenty one Years  
from the first day of November next, The Glebe of said  
Parish to be Titheable according to an agreement made  
between the Rev<sup>d</sup> Richard Hamilton Rector of said Parish  
and a Special Vestry held in the Church of said Parish  
on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of June One Thousand Eight Hundred  
and Twenty seven, and which sum is due and payable to  
the Rev<sup>d</sup> Rich<sup>d</sup> Hamilton Rector of the above mentioned  
Parish
