

= parish from year to year at the low rate of  
sixty pounds sterling per annum, to one of the  
tithe payers in trust for the benefit of the entire  
parish. and it appearing to me that such  
sum is not a just equivalent for the tithe  
of said parish, I have added one fifth of  
said sum so paid as aforesaid,  
pursuant to the powers in me vested  
making in the entire the aforesaid sum  
of seventy and two pounds sterling, and  
I do further certify that the average  
price of oats being the principal corn  
growing in said parish for the period of  
seven years ending on the first day  
of November one thousand eight hundred  
and thirty is twelve shillings and  
seven pence half penny per barrel  
according to the Dublin Gazette.
