within the Parish of Cloncurry in the County of Kildare, do hereby certify
that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatever
within the said Parish is One Hundred pounds Sterling -

Which Sum is due and payable to The Very Rev^d Thomas French
Dean of Kildare -

And We do further certify that the Average price of Wheat
being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the period of
Seven Years next preceding 1821 £1..18..8 $\frac{1}{2}$ per Barrel

We the above named Commissioners pursuant to the powers vested in us
by the 26th Section of the 4th Geo - 4th Cap - 99 - have determined the
Average Amount of the Tithes of the Parish of Cloncurry for the
period of Seven Years next preceding 1821 at Eighty Eight pounds
eleven Shillings and five pence farthing Sterling per Annum,
But in consideration of the said Average Amount of Eighty eight
pounds eleven Shillings and five pence farthing Sterling having
been ascertained from Leases made by The Incumbent for the
aforesaid period, And that certain expence of Agency and trouble
will necessarily arise under the present arrangement, We have
agreed to add the Sum of Seven pounds eight Shillings and six
pence three farthings Sterling to the above Sum - Making the full
Sum of One hundred pounds Sterling per Annum -
