

We Edward Medlicott Esquire of Dummerway and Rev^d William Cox Rector of Kildangan, Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth year of the Reign of King George The Fourth "intituted an Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited Time" to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable within the Parish of Cloneurvy in the County of Kildare do hereby certify that the true and just Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish is One Hundred pounds Sterling, Which Sum is due and payable to the Very Rev^d Thomas French Dean of Kildare.

And We do further certify that the Average Price of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in such County, for the period of seven years next preceeding 1821 one £1.18.8 1/2 per Barrel.

We the above named Commissioners pursuant to the powers vested in us by the 26 Section of the 4th Geo-4- Cap. 99 have determined the Average Amount of the Tithes of the Parish of Cloneurvy for the period of seven years next preceeding 1821 one at Eighty eight pounds Eleven Shillings and five pence farthing Sterling per Annum, But in consideration of the said Average Amount of Eighty eight pounds eleven Shillings and five pence farthing Sterling having been ascertained from Leases made by the Incumbent for the aforesaid period, and that certain expence of Agency and trouble will necessarily arise under the present arrangement, We have agreed to add the Sum of Eleven pounds eight Shillings and Six pence three farthings Sterling to the above Sum, making the full Sum of One hundred pounds Sterling per Annum -
