We Nicholas Lett and Richard Waddy Elgee, Commissioners
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in
the fourth year of the Reign of King George the Fourth, intituled "An
Act to provide for the establishing of Compositions for Tithes in
Ireland for a limited time," to ascertain and fix a true and just
composition for all Tithes arising, growing, yielded or payable
within the Parish of Coalisuff in the County of Waterford, do hereby
certify that the Rev^d George Richards, Incumbent of the said Parish,
has agreed to receive the fixed Annual Sum of Two Hundred
Pounds Sterling invariable for the Term of Twenty one Years as the
Amount of Composition for the said Tithes, and has obtained the
consent of The Right Reverend The Lord Bishop of Ferns and
Leighlin, Patron of the said Parish, to the said Agreement, in
Writing and signed by The said Lord Bishop; - and the said
Agreement has been made, signified, assented to, and accepted at
a Vestry of the said Parish held on Monday the 9th day of May
1831, in manner required by the said recited Act. - And We do further
certify that the whole of the said Sum is due and payable to the said
Rev^d George Richards as a Composition for the Tithes claimable
by Him as Rector of the said Parish... Given under our Hands
the 31st of May 1831...
