to this Special Vestry

Resolved that the sum of Two Hundred pounds ster-
by the year be paid to the Rev. Geo. Richards and
his successors, Rectors of the Parish of Coolstiffe, or
and for a Composition for all Tithes payable out
of the said parish to the said Geo. Richards; and
his said successors and that the amount of
said Compositions shall be and the same is
herely agreed upon and declared to be obligatory
for twenty one years from the commencement
of the same.

Resolved that Mr. Richd. Lett of Ballingt. town
be appointed the Com. assessor on the part
of the Parishians to carry the said Compositions into
effect
