We Hamilton Law and John Lanphier being duly appointed Commissioners for the Fifth Composition and Apportionment of the Parish of Corogue more having fixed the Fifth Composition thereof at Twenty Two pounds ten Shillings being one half part thereof due and payable to the Rev^d R. P. Vaughan as Incumbent of said parish do Certify to the best of our knowledge the said Parish contains Four Hundred and fifty acres Irish Plantations Measure Fifthable and we do therefore app^r each acre to pay at the Rate of One Shilling for the one part thereof and in proportion for Road and perches the same to be levied in Each Year upon the foregoing Occupiers of the respective lands in said Parish according to the Act in that Case made and provided as Witness our hands this 28th day of February 1830
