County of Wick, do hereby certify that the true & just Amount of
Composition for all the Tithes whatsoev^r within the said Parish is -
Two Hundred & Fifty Pounds Sterling ↪ of which Sum,
One Hundred & Twenty five Pounds Sterling is due and payable to
Henry Henry of Mansfield Esq^r, as Renting the Rectorial Tithes.

and One Hundred & Twenty five Pounds Ster^l, is due & payable to
the Rev^d Richard Butler as Vicar of said Parish ↪

And, I do further certify that the average price of Wheat,
being the Corn principally grown in D. County for the Period of seven
years, ending on the 31st day of October 1830 (Thirty) is One Pound
Twelve Shillings & one half penny per Barrel ↪
