time to ascertain the true & just composition for all the rising farms of
quitting or paying within the Parish of Danesbury in the County of Meath
do certify that the true & just composition for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is rightly found to be by the Year of which Term of Tithes is made
the whole is due & payable to the Rev. John Toller as a composition for the Tithes
claimable by him as Rector of said Parish

And we do further certify that the average price of Wheat being the best
principally grown in such County for the space of seven Years ending on the
1st day of Nov^r 1811 is one pound Eighteen Shillings & Eight pence half penny
the said Sum of Money according to the late Irish Currency of Ireland
