Kildare, as Rector of said Parish
amounting to one hundred and forty
five pounds five and two pence and
The small Tithes are due and paya
ble to the Rev^d J^os Harcey, amount
ing to fifty four pounds, two shillings
and two pence, as a composition for the
Tithes claimable by him -

And I do further certify that the average
price of Oats being the corn principally
grown in said County, for the period of
seven years ending on the first day of
Nov^r 1830 is twelve shillings and six
pence halfpenny per barrel
