And I do further certify that the Average Price
of Wheat being the Corn principally grown in the said
County of the City of Limerick for the Period of 7 Years
ending on the 1st day of November 1830 is One Pound
Ten Shillings and Three pence Halfpenny for Barrell of 20
Stone -
