I Christopher Byrd Commissioner having been
duly appointed and sworn under and by Virtue of an Act
made in the Second and Third years of the Reign of his
Majesty King William the Fourth, Entitled an Act
amongst three Acts passed respectively in the Fourth Fifth
and in the Seventh and Eighth years of the Reign of his late
Majesty King George the Fourth providing for the
establishing of Compositions for Tithes in Ireland and to
make such Compositions permanent; and by Virtue of
said Act to ascertain and fix a true and just Composition
for all Tithes arising growing belonging to or payable
within the Parish of Donadea and County of Wicklow.

Do hereby Certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the said Parish
of Donadea is one hundred and twenty five Pounds four shillings
and nine pence half penny of which sum of one hundred and twenty
five Pounds four shillings and nine pence half penny the sum of
fifty Pounds four shillings and nine pence half penny is
payable by the Townland of Staplestown
