duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue
of an act made in the Fourth year of the Reign
of King George the Fourth, Entituled an Act to
provide for the establishing of Compositions for
Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain
and fix a true and just Composition for all
Tithes Arising, Growing, Yielding, Or payable,
within the Parish of Donagh in the County of
Donegal, Do hereby Certify that the true and just
amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within
the said Parish is Three Hundred and Sixty five
Pounds British $\text{£}365$ by the year by agreement,
to continue for the Term of Twentyone years from
the first day of November next, which sum is due
and payable annually to The Rev: George Marshall
or his Successors Rectors of said Parish for the
space of Twentyone years, The said Rev: George
Marshall being the only Claimant of Tithes in
said Parish Given under our hands this 19th
day of June 1828 —
