and of which sum of **ONE Hundred & Ninety Pounds** —
the sum of **Ninety five Pounds** — is payable
by the year to Sir John Dix Vicar of Woodstock and the sum
of **Ninety five Pounds** — payable by the year
to Sir Patrick James Vicar of Widdowghat County of Kildare
and to commence from the 1st day of November next for the
term of twenty one years
