 Hundred and sixty five pounds Sterling by the Year, of
 which Sum of Four Hundred and sixty five pounds, One
 third part is due and payable to the Rev^d William Henry
 Pratt Vicar of said Parish as a Composition for the
 Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish, Two
 Third parts is due and payable to Blayney Wade Esq^r
 as Lessee under the Lord Bishop of Clogher of the Rectorial
 Appropriate Tithes of said Parish. And We do further
 Certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn,
 principally grown in such County for the period of
 Seven Years ending on the first day of November 1832;
