We, Ralph Judgeon and Henry George Johnston
Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by
virtue of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign
of King George the Fourth intituled "an Act to provide
for the establishing of Composition for Tithes in Ireland
for a limited time" to ascertain and fix a true and
just Composition for all Tithes arising growing,
yielded or payable within the Parish of Donagh in the
County of Monaghan and Diocese of Clogher. Do
hereby Certify, that the true and just amount of Composition
for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is Four
Hundred and sixty five pounds Sterling by the Year, of
which sum of Four Hundred and sixty five pounds, One
third part is due and payable to the Rev^d William Henry
Pratt Vicar of said Parish as a Composition for the
Tithe claimable by him as Vicar of said Parish, Two
Third parts is due and payable to Blayney Wade Esqre
as Lessee under the Lord Bishop of Clogher of the Rectorial
Appropriate Tithes of said Parish. And we do further
Certify that the average price of Oats being the Corn
principally grown in such County for the period of
seven Years ending on the first day of November 1832;
is
