

Certificate of composition for the Parish of Donamine in the Diocese of Clogher, County of Monaghan from November the first 1823 for twenty one years -

We ~~Heretofore~~ Daniel and Harvey Pratt Esquires Commissioners duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of King George the Fourth intituled an Act to provide for the establishing of compositions for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time to ascertain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes arising growing yielded or payable within the Parish of Donamine in the County of Monaghan do hereby certify that the true and just amount of compositions for all Tithes whatever within the said Parish is one thousand five hundred and fifty Pounds ~~per~~ ^{per} the year. Of which sum of one thousand five hundred and fifty Pounds ~~one third part~~ ^{one third part} is due and payable to the Reverend John Grey Porter as a Composition for the tithes claimable by him as Vicar of the said Parish together with ^{another third part being} a moiety of the Rectorial Tithes to him belonging, and one third part ^{is due and payable to} John Boyle Kerran Esquire ^{in perpetuity} of the Incumbent of said Parish

And we do further certify that the average price of oats being the corn principally sown in such County for the period of seven years ending on the first day of November 1821 is fifteen shillings
