Compositions permanent" to ascertain & fix a true
& just Composition for all Tithes arising, growing,
yielded or payable within the Parish of Dawolstown
in the County of Meath do hereby Certify that the
true & just Amount of Compositions for all Tithes
substantiated within the said Parish is Sixty two
Pounds

by the year of
which sum of Sixty two Pounds
Two thirds or Forty one Pounds Six Shillings & eight pence
one shilling & payable to Peter Metzger Esq. as a Composition
for the Tithes claimable by him as owner of the Rectorial
Tithe of the said Parish & One third or Twenty Pounds
Three shillings & four pence are due &
payable to the Reverend Richard Madeliff as Vicar
of the said Parish.

And I do further Certify that the Average Price of Oats
being the same principally grown in such County
for the Period of 7 years ending on the first day of
November 1830 is Fifteen Shillings & three pence
three farthings & a Barrel
