and by the Rev.<sup>d</sup> John Ductelle, as Patron of the Vicarage of  
the v.<sup>d</sup> Parish of Droghetta - as appears to us by a Writing  
and Agreement signed Thomas Hogan, Chairman  
and nineteen other persons entitled to Vote at said Vestry  
with the signatures of the Rev.<sup>d</sup> John Ductelle Rector, and the  
Rev.<sup>d</sup> Richard Haste, Vicar of v.<sup>d</sup> Parish of Droghetta -  
together with the signature of the Rev. James W. Forster LL.D.  
Vicar General, by virtue of a Commission from the Lord Bishop  
of Limerick, and also the Rev.<sup>d</sup> John Ductelle Prebendary of
