

At a Special meeting of the parishioners of  
the parish of Dechidharana, in the County of  
Down, duly assembled and  
duly called this twentieth day of March  
1826 was agreeable to the acts of Parliament  
of the 4<sup>th</sup> of George the 4<sup>th</sup> Chap 99 - and the  
5<sup>th</sup> of George the 4<sup>th</sup> Chap 63 - providing  
for the establishing of composition for tithes  
in Ireland - It was resolved and unani-  
-mously agreed to pay unto the Rev<sup>d</sup>  
John Buddell Pastor of the parish of Dechid-  
-harana the sum of forty three pounds  
one shilling and six pence half penny  
British yearly for twenty one years  
from the first day of May next  
ensuing without any abatement in  
the price of Corn and to hereby ap-  
-point and nominate John Christie Esq<sup>r</sup>  
of the House as a fit person to be a Com-  
-missioner on behalf of the owners &  
occupiers of Land in said parish  
of Dechidharana for carrying into  
execution the purposes of the said  
acts
