

At a special meeting of the parishes of  
of the Parish of Duhallow in the County  
and Group of Towns duly assembled and  
duly called this twentieth day of March 1845  
agreeable to the act of Parliament of the  
4<sup>th</sup> of George the 4<sup>th</sup> chap 99 - and the 5<sup>th</sup> of  
George the 4<sup>th</sup> chap 63 providing for  
the establishment of Compensation for  
Tithes in Ireland - It was resolved and  
unanimously agreed to pay unto the Rev  
Richard Harte vicar of the parish of  
Duhallow the sum of twenty pounds  
ten shillings and nine pence  $\frac{1}{4}$  British  
yearly for twenty one years from the  
first day of May next ensuing without  
any variation in the price of Corn and  
We hereby appoint and nominate  
John Christie Esq of Adarell as a fit and proper  
person to be a Commissioner on behalf  
of the owners and occupiers of land  
in the said parish of Duhallow  
for carrying into execution the pur-  
poses of said acts
