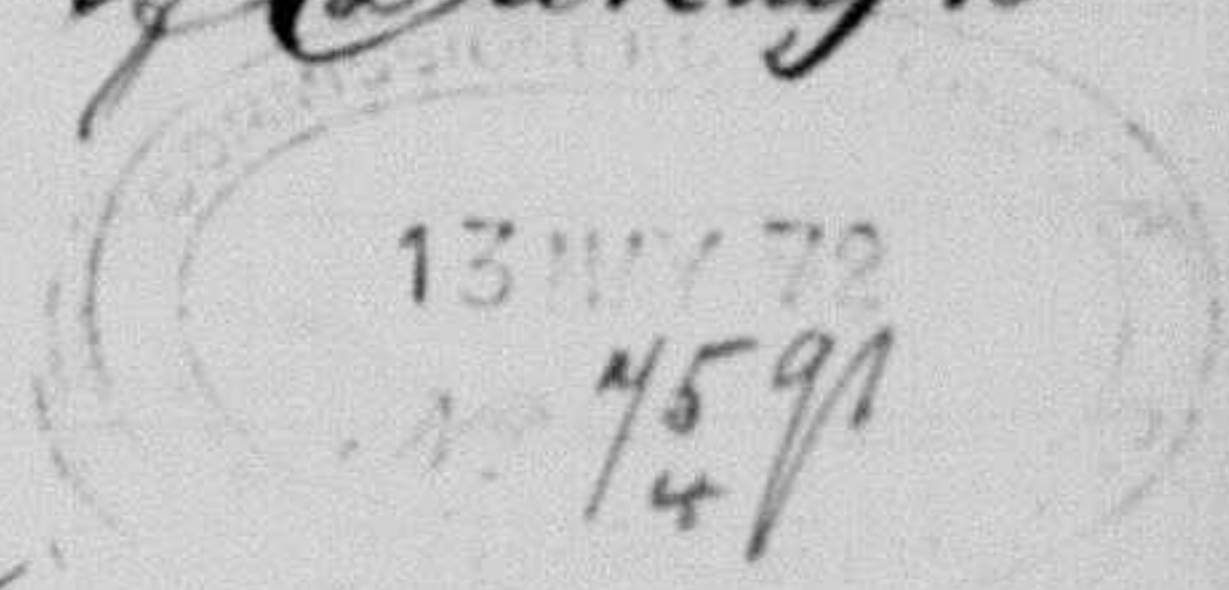

Peace in and for the
County of Cork At a

General Sessions of the Peace holden at
Skibbereen in and for the division of County in
said Cork County West Riding on the 8th day of October
1868

Whereas due notice of application having
been first affixed at the time and in the manner directed
by the Statutes in such case made and provided by the
Rev^{William} Moyers Woolsey Vicar of the Parish of Drinagh in the
Cork County West Riding and Division aforesaid being
one of the parties entitled to and in actual receipt of
Rent Charge in lieu of composition for Tithes arising
and payable in respect of the said several lands charge-
able therewith in the Parish of Drinagh aforesaid in
the said County Riding and Division in pursuance of
a certain certificate bearing date the 25th June 1833
whereby the gross amount of composition for
all
