payable within the Parish of Drinahilly in the
County of Wickham, Diocese of Ferns, do hereby certify that
the true and just amount of composition for all Tithes what-
ever within the said Parish is Ninety nine pounds four
Shillings and one half penny sterling by the year which
said sum of £99 4 02 is due and payable to the
Rev^d William Fickey as composition for all Tithes
claimable by him as Incumbent of the said Parish.

I do further certify that the average price of
wheat being the corn principally grown in the said Parish
for the seven years preceding the first of Nov^r 1830
is Twelve Shillings and eleven pence half penny & Barrel
as extracted from the Dublin Gazette.
