year of the Reign of King George the 4<sup>th</sup> entitled  
an act to provide for the establishing of composition  
for Tithes in Ireland for a limited time, to ascertain  
and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes  
arising growing yielding or payable within the  
parish of Dromard in the County of Sligo, do  
hereby certify that the true and just amount of  
composition for all Tithes whatever within the said  
parish is Two hundred and Eighty pounds by  
the year, and which sum of Two hundred and  
Eighty pounds are due and payable to the  
Reverend John Stada as a composition for the  
Tithe claimable by him as Rector of the said  
parish - and we do further certify that  
the average price of Oats being the Corn principally  
grown in said County of Sligo for the period of  
Seven years ending 1<sup>st</sup> November 1821 is 11.0 per  
Barrel of 14 Stone.
