

to such average price as compared with the price stated in the said Certificate namely £1.15.0 of the late Irish Currency per Barrel being equivalent to £1.15.1 of the present Currency And whereas the said Applicants and the Rev. Mountfort Longfield Connor, Rector of said Parish having appeared by their respective Solicitors before the said Justices at such Quarter Sessions and the said Notice of Application Certificate of Composition and other documents having been proved and the said Justices having in pursuance of the Statute in that case made and provided nominated and appointed James Richard Bull to be an arbitrator to ascertain the average price of the Barrel of good Marketable Wheat as advertised in the Dublin Gazette for the seven years immediately preceding the date of this present Sessions and the said James Richard Bull having by his Report in Writing under his hand duly verified on Oath certified to the said Justices that he had examined the said Gazette and taken the average price of wheat as therein advertised for said period of 7 years and that the average price of good Marketable Wheat for said seven years is £1.8.3 per Barrel Now the said Justices do find that the average price of wheat for the said seven years is as same was so reported by the said James Richard Bull as aforesaid. and that the said average price of £1.8.3 is less than more by $\frac{1}{10}^{\text{th}}$ than the said average price of £1.15.0 found by the Certificate of the Original Composition as aforesaid and do order and adjudge that the amount of said Composition for Tithes in said Parish, and the Rent Charges payable in lieu thereof shall be diminished in proportion to the difference between the said average price of £1.8.3 Sterling and the said average price of £1.15.1

and that the assessment and Apportionment of said Composition shall be amended so as to bear the same proportion to the amount of said Composition as so diminished as aforesaid, as the Original Assessment and Apportionment did bear to such Original Composition as aforesaid.
