Do hereby certify, that the true and just Com-
position for the Tithes within the said Parish is Five
Hundred and Seventy three Pounds, seventeen Shillings
and seven pence by the Year; Five Hundred and
Sixty Pounds and eight pence of which is due and payable
to the Rev. John Smythe as Rector of said Parish, and
Thirteen Pounds sixteen Shillings and three pence
to Edward Botter (five Eighths) as Lay Impropriator of
certain Lands within said Parish. And I further certify
that the Average price of Wheat, being the most principal
grain in the County for the Period ending 1st of November 1830
is One Pound twelve Shillings, & one Penny per Bushel
