certain and fix a true and just composition for all Tithes
arising growing yielded or payable within the parish of Drom
in the County of Kerry do hereby certify that the true and just
Amount of Composition for all Tithes whatsoever within the Said
Parish is Five Hundred and forty four pounds Sixteen Shil-
lings and Eight pence Sterling by the year the whole of
which Sum is due and payable to the Rev^d Don^o Lucas
as a composition for the Tithes claimable by him as Rector
and Vicar of the Said Parish for the term of Twenty one
years from the date hereof ~

And we do further certify that the average price
of Wate being the corn principally grown in Such County
for the period of Seven years ending the 1st day of
November 1821 is fourteen Shillings a Barrel given
under our hands this 20th day of April 1825
