We The Commissioners for the parish
of Drumcree in the Diocese of Armagh, duly
appointed and sworn under and by virtue
~~of~~ of the Act of the 4th year of the reign
of King George the 4th - Entitled an Act
for Establishing Composition for tithes in Ireland
for a limited time, do herewith forward to you
a duplicate of the Apportionment of the Compo-
sition for the Rectorial tithes of the said
Parish of ^{Drumcree} ~~Armagh~~, according to the provisions
of the said Act, which Composition was
agreed to be annually paid for twenty one
years by the Landholders of said parish, to
the Reverend Jerome Alley the person entitled
to said tithes, by half yearly rates, the first
rate to be paid or payable on the 5th day of
November 1826 - at a Vestry held in and for
the said parish on the 8th day of February
1826, and also at a Special Vestry held in
and for the said parish by Order of His Ca-
pitany the Lord Lieutenant, on the 13th day
of July 1826 - And we require you, in
compliance with the 21st Section of the Act
