We John De Vere and Robert Thompson Esq
being nominated and appointed Commit-
tees by a Vestry held ^{on the 8th day of February 1826} in and for the parish
of Downham in the County of North, for the
purpose of carrying into execution the provi-
sions of the Acts of the 4th and 5th of the
King for establishing compositions for tithes
in Ireland for a limited period - and the
said nomination and appointment having
been confirmed by a Special Vestry held in
and for the said Parish by Order of His
Excellency the Lord Lieutenant on the 12th
day of July 1826 - Do hereby certify that
the aforesaid Vestry of the 8th of February
1826 did agree to pay by the year, the sum
of Two Hundred and Eighty pounds Ster-
ling of British Currency to the Reverend
George Abbot (the person authorized to re-
ceive the Rectorial tithes of said Parish) and
And we do further certify that the said Spe-
cial Vestry of the 12th of July 1826 did con-
firm and adopt the said agreement - and
that the average price of Wheat and Oats (being
the principal corn grown in said County was
- for Wheat £1:10:0- and for Oats £0:15:2 1/2
