I the Reverend Alexander Johnston of
Brantford in the County of South do swear that
I will faithfully, impartially and honestly, accord-
ing to the best of my skill and ~~judgment~~ ability
execute and perform the power and authorities
vested in me as Commissioner in the parish
of Brantford aforesaid by virtue of an Act
passed in the 4th year of the reign of King
George the 4th Entitled An Act for Sett-
ling a Commission for tithes in Ireland for
a limited time - according to the directions
of the said Act and according to Equity and
good Conscience, and without favor or affection,
prejudice or malice to any person or persons
& Commission - So help me God -

On the 2 May 1827 - The subscription
was forwarded to this Office The Lord Primate
and Mr Goulborne of the Department of Com-
missioners for the Parish of Brantford - of which
the following is a copy - See Act Sect. of Act 4 of Geo. 4

My Lord We have the honor to inform you here-
that at a Special Meeting held by Order of His Ex-
cellency the Lord Lieutenant on and for the parish
of Brantford in the County of South on the 30th day
of April 1827 - The Reverend Alexander Johnston
of Brantford in the said County and Francis George
of Newboro in the said County, were appointed
Commissioners (under and by virtue of the Act of the
4th year of the reign of King George the 4th for set-
tling a Commission for tithes in Ireland for a
limited time) for applying the Commission for
all tithes growing payable in said parish -
which Commission was agreed to by the Reverend
James Alty Rector and by the Landholders of
said parish -
