

At a special Vestry held at the  
Parish Church of Dromeliffe, in the  
Diocese of Killaloe, and County of Clare  
on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October, 1824, It was agreed  
upon by the Rev<sup>d</sup> Michael Fitz Gerald, Vicar  
of said Parish, and the Parishioners in Vestry  
assembled that the sum of One Hundred  
and Forty Pounds a year, <sup>to the said Vicar</sup> be paid for the  
term of Twenty one years, in lieu of the Vicarial  
Tithes of said Parish, under the provisions of  
the several acts of the 4<sup>th</sup> of George 4<sup>th</sup> Chap 99,  
and 5<sup>th</sup> of George 4<sup>th</sup> Chapter 63. - Given under  
my hand this 2<sup>d</sup> day of October 1824.
