Viz. Lifford East, Lifford West, Lifford North, Inch commonly called Middle Division, Knockanivan, Inchiboy East, Inchiboy West, Inch, Moyle, Cor, Shanawagh, Dromeliff, Inchiboy, Poulacorney a parcel, Mahonagh, a parcel, Killybeg, Craughan, Ballylaurie, Craughan, Gortmore, Craughan, Tullaghan, Craughan, Craughan, Craughan, as Rector of said Parish, and the sum of one hundred and ten pounds Sterling are due and payable to Robert Keane (Esq.) out of the following lands.
