

Special Vestry  
1824

At a Special Vestry held at the  
Parish Church of Donnelcliffe, in the  
Diocese of Meath, and County of Clare  
on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October, 1824, It was agreed  
upon by the Rev Michael Fitz Gerald, Vicar  
of said Parish, and the Parishioners in Vestry  
assembled that the sum of One Hundred  
and Forty Pounds a year, to be paid <sup>to the said Vicar</sup> for the  
term of Twenty one years, in lieu of the Vicarial  
Tithes of said Parish, under the provisions of  
the several acts of the 4<sup>th</sup> of George 4<sup>th</sup> Chap 99,  
and 5<sup>th</sup> of George 4<sup>th</sup> Chapter 63. - Given under  
my hand this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of October 1824.
