We John Gore Jones and Edward Henderson, Comrs
duly appointed and sworn under and by virtue of an Act
made in the fourth year of the reign of King George the
fourth intituled "An Act to provide for the establishing
of Compositions for tithes in Ireland for a limited time"
to ascertain and fix a true Composition for all tithes
raising, growing, yealded, or payable within the
Parish of Drumcliff in the County of Sligo,
do hereby Certify that the true and just amount
of Composition for all tithes whatsoever within the said
Parish is Seven Hundred and Eighty pounds viz by
the year of which sum of Seven Hundred and Eighty
pounds viz one half are due and payable to the said
John Yates as a Composition for the Tithes claimable by
him as Vicar of said Parish, and the one other half are
due and payable to Owen Wynne Esq^r of Haselwood
as Lay Impropriator of said Parish for its tithes,
and we do further Certify that the average
price of Oats being the Com principally grown in said
County for the seven years ending on the first day of Nov^r
1824 is fifteen Shillings & two pence farthing & Banell
