

Certificate

We Maurice George Senarick Incumbent of the Parish of Drumshoban in the County of Donegal, and Edward Michael Conolly Proprietor of one third part of the tithes of said parish, do severally certify that we have each of us received from the Revd. Edward Michael Hamilton of Brown Hall, in said county, the immediate tenant of the collegiate body which is proprietor of the fee of the lands of Murrage, Fungah, Killybeggan, Aghadullagh, Ballintee, Ballinakillean, Roferty Carrickbeen Brown Hall Senarick aban, Killybeggan Large, Legumintion, Legumintion Shanagh & Sabornahony, a notice in the words and figures following " Sir, Pursuant to the provisions of the Statute made and passed in the 2^d & 3^d years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the 4th, entitled "An Act to amend 3 acts passed respectively in the 4th, 5th & in the 7th & 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the establishing of composition for tithes in Ireland & to make such compositions permanent" & of one other Statute made & passed in the 3^d & 4th years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the 4th entitled "An Act for the relief of the owners of tithes in Ireland" & for the amendment of the above recited act of the 2^d & 3^d years of the reign of his present Majesty. I hereby give you notice that I am desirous to agree for and undertake as provided by the said acts (upon your performing the matters & things prescribed & enacted by the said acts to be done & performed on your part) the future payment of the tithes composition chargeable upon, & payable and legally payable out of the Townlands & premises hereinafter particularly described & mentioned, with their several denominations, situated being & being, within the parish of Drumshoban in the County of Donegal, & bounded as follows, to wit: The town & lands of Murrage bounded on the north by the river of the south by Murrage gully, on the east by the sea, & on the west by the sea. Fungah, bounded on the north by Murrage, on the south by Ghaboy, on the east by Drumshoban, & on the west by Murrage. Killybeggan bounded on the north by Drumshoban on the south by Drumshoban, on the east by Killybeggan and on the west by Murrage river, Also the town & lands of Aghadullagh, Ballintee, Ballinakillean, Roferty Carrickbeen, Brown Hall, Senarick aban, Killybeggan Large, Legumintion, Legumintion Shanagh & Sabornahony, bounded on the north by Drumshoban, on the south by Murrage, on the east by Murrage, and on the west by Murrage. Senarick aban, bounded on the north by Drumshoban, on the south by Murrage, on the east by Murrage, and on the west by Murrage. Subject however to the deduction of fifteen pounds per centum on the amount of such compositions as provided by the said acts. And I hereby require you in pursuance of the said acts to grant to me a certificate under your hand & seal of the import directed by said acts in order that I may execute under my hand and seal the declaration required thereby, and I also give you notice that I am the immediate tenant of the collegiate body which is proprietor of the fee of the lands aforesaid, and that you have under which I hold the same for a term of not less than twenty one years from the date thereof, and I am ready to give you any further information in relation thereto which you may require on my receiving a notice from you to that effect.
