

Certificate.

We Maurice George Fenwick Incumbent of the Parish of Drumholton in the County of Donegal, and Edward Michael Conolly Impropriator of one third part of the tithes of said parish, do severally certify that we have each of us acted from the Rect. Edward Michael Hamilton of Brown Hall, in said county, the immediate tenant of the collegiate body which is possessor of the fee of the lands of Murrage, Finght, Ballybulgan, Aghastullagh, Ballyntier, Ballynahillan, Papaty Carnachreen Brown Hall Knockaban, Kellough Longy Lagrimontey Lagranormey Shanagh & Tobornahurry, a notice in the words and figures following " Sir, Pursuant to the provisions of the Statute made and passed in the 2^d & 3^d years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the 4th entitled "An Act to amend 3 acts passed respectively in the 4th 5th & in the 7th 8th years of the reign of his late Majesty King George the 4th providing for the establishment of composition for tithes in Ireland & to make such compositions permanent" & of one other Statute made & passed in the 3^d & 4th years of the reign of his present Majesty King William the 4th entitled "An Act for the relief of the owners of tithes in Ireland" & for the amendment of the above recited act of the 2^d & 3^d years of the reign of his present Majesty. I hereby give you notice that I am desirous to agree for and undertake as provided by the said Acts (upon your performing the matters & things prescribed & enacted by the said acts to be done & performed on your part) the future payment of the tithes composition chargeable upon, defensible and legally payable out of the Townlands & premises hereinafter particularly described & mentioned, with their usual denominations, situated lying & being, within the parish of Drumholton in the County of Donegal, to wit: the Town & lands of Murrage bounded on the north by the sea, on the south by Murrage glen, on the East by the sea, & on the west by the sea. Finght, bounded North by Binn, on the South by Ghabloy, on the East by Drumon, & on the west by Binn. Ballybulgan bounded on the North by Drumon on the south by Drumon. Papaty by Killygla and on the west by Murrage river, Also the Towns & lands of Aghastullagh Ballyntier Ballynahillan Papaty Carnachreen Brown Hall Knockaban Kellough Longy Lagrimontey Lagranormey Shanagh & Tobornahurry, bounded on the north by Drumon, on the south by Rosally Mounbarn and Woodmossie mountain, on the south by Park Hill, Demis, Ballyalla & Ballypuck part of Brown Hall demesne, Ballyntier Park Ballydemet & Aghastullagh, on the East by Mounbarn, and on the west by Ballyntier Fenwick Mounmore Grahamston Drumon & Larkburn Subject however to the deduction of fifteen pounds per centum on the amount of each composition as provided by the said acts. And I hereby require you in pursuance of the said acts to grant to me a certificate under your hand & seal of the import directed by said acts in order that I may execute under my hand and seal the declaration required thereby, and I also give you notice that I am the immediate tenant of the collegiate body which is possessor of the fee of the lands aforesaid, and that the lease under which I hold the same is for a term of not less than twenty one years from the date thereof, and I am ready to give you any further information in relation thereto which you may require on my receiving a notice from you to that effect.
