

In the matter of the Appeal of the Parishioners of the Parish of Drumlease in the County of Litchim.

The Matter of the said Appeal having been referred to me by Order of the Lord Lieutenant & Council bearing date the 14<sup>th</sup> day of April 1834. I proceeded accordingly to the Hearing thereof, and having examined all such Witnesses & other Evidence as have been brought before me & heard Counsel on behalf of Appellants & Respondents. Have Ordered & determined that the Certificate of the Commissioners (so far as the same regards the Sum therein stated to have been agreed upon by the Incumbent & the Parishioners to be the Amount of the Composition) be Modified & decreased from One hundred & thirty Pounds (being the Sum stated in said Certificate) to One hundred & twenty five Pounds, which latter Sum appears by the Evidence to have been the Sum in terms agreed upon by the Parties, to be the Amount of the Composition, and I do hereby Order that the said Sum of One hundred & twenty five Pounds be received in their respective proportions by the Parties entitled thereto, respectively, as the Amount of said Composition in lieu of the said Sum of One hundred & thirty Pounds.
