by virtue of one Act made in the Tenth
year of the Reign of King George the 4th entitled
an Act to provide for Establishing a Compensation
of Tithes for a limited time to a certain and
fix a true and just compensation for all
Tithes, arable, meadow, or pasture, or
Meadow, or the Tithes of Decumbrance (exclusive
of that part of the Tithes subject to General
Tithes only) in the County of Chen. We do hereby
Certify that the true and just amount of
Compensation for all Arable Tithes, on said
Parish, is 10/6 which sum is due and pay-
able to the said Wm. Cullack Vicar of said
Parish, and the sum of 60 for all Arable
Tithes due and payable to Henry Duntley by
virtue of the said Act, and the said Vicar of said Parish
