do hereby certify that the true and just amount of  
composition for all tithes arising growing payable  
within the parish of Dumblane in the county  
of Dumfries do hereby certify that the true and just amount of  
composition for all tithes arising growing payable  
within the said parish is five hundred and  
thirty pounds sterling by the year, of which sum of five  
hundred and twenty pounds, three hundred and thirty  
are due to The Rev<sup>d</sup> Christopher Robinson vicar, and  
the residue two hundred and forty pounds is due to the  
Parish Incumbent - and we do further certify that the  
average price of oats being the ear principally grown  
in the said county for seven years ending on the 31<sup>st</sup>  
October 1821 is fifteen shillings and two pence per  
bushel according to the returns a duplicate in the Dublin  
Gazette for said year
