

Now the undersigned commissioners duly appointed  
and sworn to carry into effect the provisions of  
the Tithes Composition Act for the parish of Baskin  
in the C<sup>o</sup> Westmeath and Drogheda of Meath  
having caused surveys and estimates to be made  
of all lands in said parish valuing the best  
land at £1-10-0 p<sup>r</sup> acre the 2<sup>d</sup> quality at the rate  
of £1-0-0 p<sup>r</sup> acre & the 3<sup>d</sup> quality at the rate  
of ten shillings p<sup>r</sup> acre to be submitted to the  
inspection of the Commissioners and having  
appointed a day to hear such objections  
as might be offered thereto in conformity with  
the 21<sup>st</sup> section of the 1<sup>st</sup> of the King Chap 99  
& having provided at subsequent meetings  
to investigate the same & having made  
such objections as to us appeared just and  
equitable. Do hereby confirm the foregoing  
App<sup>t</sup> to print dated this 7<sup>th</sup> of May 1827

At a Special Vestry held on the 28<sup>th</sup>  
day of August 1826 in the parish Church  
of Drumrany in the C<sup>o</sup> Westmeath and  
Drogheda of Meath under the 1<sup>st</sup> Geo 4<sup>th</sup> Chap 99  
entitled an Act to provide for the establishment  
of composition for Tithes in Ireland for a limited  
term. To ascertain a true & just composition  
for all Tithes arising growing yielded & payable  
within the parish of Baskin in the C<sup>o</sup> Westmeath  
and Drogheda of Meath. It was unanimously  
agreed that the sum of forty one pounds fifteen  
shillings & sixpence British currency be paid to  
the Rev<sup>d</sup> Samuel Lucas for all Tithes claimable  
by him as Rector & Vicar of said parish & that the  
said sum of 290-15-0 shall continue to be paid for 7 <sup>years</sup>  
not subject to any alteration  
and we Do further Certify that
